Next month, **The Studio Theatre™ Tierra del Sol** (806 San Marino Drive, The Villages, FL) will kick-off its second season with a Central Florida Premiere of *Bad Jews*, the critically acclaimed and Outer Critics Circle Award Nominee by Joshua Harmon.

Set against the backdrop of 21st century Manhattan, *Bad Jews* asks questions about what you choose to believe when you're chosen. The patriarch of a Jewish family passes away, and three very different grandchildren gather at his funeral. When Liam brings home his shiksa girlfriend Melody and declares ownership of their grandfather's Chai necklace, a vicious and hilarious brawl over family, faith, and legacy ensues.



Playing the role of Liam is New York actor, playwright, and teacher **Adam Lubitz**. Prior to arriving at The Studio Theatre, Lubitz was a professor of Theatre History and also taught stage dialects at the New York Conservatory of Dramatic Arts. Adam holds a B.A. from Brown University, and a Master of Fine Arts from Columbia University's School of the Arts. His new musical that he titled, "The Wonderful Wizard of Oz; Based on the Book by L. Frank Baum for a Post-Wicked Age," was produced in New York last year.

Lubitz recently starred in the award-winning independent mystery, *Nadia Knows*, as well as NatGeo channel's *I Am Legend: Phreaks and Geeks.* After *Bad Jews* closes, Lubitz plans to re-mount his solo show in early 2018, titled, "*It's Not The End of the World.*" Adam is a member of Actor's Equity Association.
