Frankie and Johnny is the story of Frankie, a waitress, and Johnny, a short-order cook, who work together in the same restaurant. Lights up on Frankie and Johnny in the bed of a grimy 1987 New York studio apartment. Frankie is hopeful that Johnny will now put on his clothes and depart, but Johnny, the romantic, has other ideas. Through sometimes touching and sometimes hilarious banter shared over sandwiches and a song, the promise of a relationship beyond a "one-night stand" begins to emerge for these two lonely hearts.



Playing the lead role of Frankie is The Studio Theatre's Artistic Director **Whitney Morse**. Last season, Morse starred in *Next to Normal* as Diana Goodman, of which, patron J. Scott Berry praised Morse's performance, "Whitney Morse is absolutely amazing as Diana." Libby Champion of BroadwayWorld called Morse's portrayal of Cathy in *The Last Five Years* at The Studio "absolutely amazing." Whitney closed out season one playing Claire in *Proof*. Over the summer, she wowed sold-out crowds at The Studio Theatre in *Songs for a New World*. Currently residing in Winter Garden, Florida, Llorens has been in the industry for over 18 years, and plans to put together a show for Orlando

Fringe at the conclusion of *Frankie and Johnny*. This is Lloren's first time performing at The Studio Theatre Tierra del Sol. He is a proud member of the Actors' Equity Association.

The Understudy for Frankie will be Orlando based-actress, **Sarah Lockard**, who recently worked with Morse in Mad Cow Theatre's all-female production of *1776*, and she also worked with Llorens in *Picasso at the Lapin Agile*. Kissimmee actor, **Timmy Walczak** who was recently seen in Victory Productions' *Moonlight and Magnolias* will understudy the role of Johnny.
