a second, contrasting monologue ready and bring music for another song in case it is asked of you.

There will not be an accompanist present between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. during auditions on June 9, so if you're auditioning for the musicals, do not come during those hours.

To be considered for the plays only, prepare a relevant 90-second monologue and have a second contrasting monologue ready in case it is requested.

"We will be looking for honesty, virtuosity and versatility in their work," Morse said.

The Studio Theatre practices nontraditional casting, meaning there is no discrimination based on age, race, gender or disability. It also currently casts both non-union talent and those within the Actors' Equity Association under the Orlando Area Theatre contract.

The Studio isn't only looking for local talent. Additional auditions are scheduled from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. May 30 and 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. May 31 at Stage 773 in Chicago. Actors from the Windy City have performed in previous Studio Theatre productions.
